



## \$22 million for IDM projects

ROBOTS that are made in Singapore, computer games that can sense a player's mood, and software that can automatically draw animation sequences – these are some of the things that could be made in Singapore in three to four years' time.

They are part of 14 interactive digital media

(IDM) research projects by the National University of Singapore, Nanyang Technological University and Nanyang Polytechnic, which have received \$22 million from the National Research Fund.

The research is expected to involve about 400 students and more than 100 faculty members.
